

Welcome to island hopping in the Oslofjord

On the West side of the Oslofjord, approaching Oslo there is an archipelago. «Verdens Ende» (World's end) and «Færder Fyr» (Færder Lighthouse) is located in the South, while «Bolærne» is located in the North and protects hundreds of little islands and skerries.

«Fulehuk Fyr» (Fulehuk Lighthouse) is located East of the archipelago. The lighthouse has been closed down and replaced by a fully automatic lighthouse – Hollenderbåen, Today «Fulehuk's Friends» have taken on the task of preserving and restoring this unique heritage. Here it is possible to come on day trips or you can stay overnight. The lighthouse can be rented to celebrate birthday, wedding or others unforgettable events, or just to enjoy the spectacular view with friends.

The Bolærne archipelago consists of three islands, «Østre» (Eastern), «Mellom» (Central) and «Vestre» (Western), where we find traces of settlement from the 17th century. All the Islands were occupied by the military from 1916 with no access for civilian population. In 2005 the islands were released and are since then open for visitors.

The former military garrison was on the «Østre (Eastern) Bolæren». At the top is the «Signal station» and canon positions. Today anyone has the opportunity to spend summer vacation on the island, whether you have your own boat or a rented room/cabin.

«Mellom (Cental) Bolæren» is a paradise of a variety of wonderful nature and coastal culture. Along the coast path, we find many memories of earlier settlement including a restored farm cottage and a restored summer cottage, built by the count Wedel Jarlsberg in 1845.

On the other side of «Jensesund» you find «Vestre (Western) Bolæren». In the previous workshops you will find «Ladestasjonen Summer Café», cabins to rent, Fish Club Cabin and «Minemagasinet» with coastal culture.

On «Kalvenga» you can explore beaches for bathing and tenting. On top of the island you find a burial mound from the Bronze Age.

In the summer «Flybåten» is in service between the islands, and the «Taxi boat» is available for smaller groups, and also for trips to Fulehuk Lighthouse. There is a shuttle bus from Tønsberg city to Flybåten and there are parking lots at the wharf at Husvik.
